- I. Rules and Guidelines:
  - A. Must maintain citizenship and academic standards given by Mark Keppel High School administration and Board of Education
  - B. Elected positions will be held throughout the 2018-2019 school year. Probation or removal from position may occur due to impeachment/failure to complete position as determined by the advisor/administration
  - C. <u>All candidates running for a Top 4 position MUST be able to enroll into 4th period Leadership</u> class for 2018-2019
  - D. <u>Applications, signatures, and last semester's grades must be turned in to the current Speaker of the</u> <u>House by start 4th period on March 1, 2018.</u>
  - E. Follow campaigning rules which include but are not limited to:
    - 1. Campaigning may not begin until after you have received your acceptance letter from the administration to run for your applied position.
    - 2. All campaigning equipment (including online media) must be approved by Business and Activites and Ms. Carmona in ASB room A-132 or A-230
    - 3. MUST USE BLUE TAPE!! (painters tape)
    - 4. Maximum of 2 banners which can be no larger than 6ft by 4ft
    - 5. No paper handouts, all handouts must have a way to attach onto clothes of backpacks
    - 6. Must display courtesy to all candidates; no tearing down or covering up of another campaigner. No negative campaigning.
    - 7. You may not loiter by the voting box during voting.
    - 8. Failure to follow these rules will result in disqualification
    - 9. Campaign posters may not be placed near the front of B-Building (palm court)
  - F. Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA
